GEORGIA FRONTIER DAYS

Believe it or not, there was once a time when Georgia was America's western frontier! Go on a journey through hundreds of years of history with live demonstrations of pre-Revolutionary times, the pioneer era and the Civil War. Meet De Soto's explorers and learn what they encountered here in the 1500's. Have a chat with General James Oglethorpe, founder of the Georgia colony. HANDS-ON HISTORY WITH PETER BONNER

Program 1: Atlanta Campaign

Your students discover not only the good and bad of the Civil War but the wacky, weird and funny, too! Peter Bonner is a local historian, actor and author with a long history of writing and performing many engaging programs for schools, television and historic sites throughout metro Atlanta.
