## **White Water Presents Its Biggest Expansion Ever** *Aloha River at Hula Hula Bay Premieres this Month*

(Branson, Missouri 5/2011) White Water, **Branson's Tropical Adventure Park**, presents its **biggest expansion ever: Aloha River at Hula Hula Bay**. This \$3 million dollar expansion is **800-plus-feet long (longer than two football fields) and holds 300,000 gallons of water -- the park's longest, wettest, coolest ride yet.**

**A splash-filled river adventure, Aloha River is an all-new area of the park, Hula Hula Bay, in a setting of lush Polynesian jungles reminiscent of the South Pacific.** Tube riders cast off and float while maneuvering the waters of Aloha River through the tropical greenery – meeting unexpected twists and turns, water features, fountains, misters, geysers and more. The immersive atmosphere of Hula Hula Bay includes elements such as colorful carved totems, plentiful fresh flowers and vegetation, and a 30-foot tall tiki tower spraying water in all directions. Along the way are new seating areas and shade, plus cabanas for riverside relaxing.

**The Ozarks' largest water park, White Water offers more than 12 acres of thrilling tropical adventures from mild to wild including the 7-story, 6-slide thrill ride, Kalani Towers**, with two 75-foot free-fall drop lanes and four mat racing lanes over 310-feet long. Additional attractions range from the double speed slide *Raging River Rapids* to *Splashaway Cay*, an interactive family attraction with slides, pumps, geysers and a 700-gallon tipping bucket. *Coconut Cove* is a play area designed for smaller kids with slides, interactive sprays and water nozzles in a shallow pool.

**White Water also presents *Nightwater* on select nights July 1 - September 3. From 10 a.m. until 10 p.m. guests can play all day and into the night**, surfing the 500,000 gallon wave pool at dusk, floating Aloha River at Hula Hula Bay under the stars, or racing down the speed slides in the dark. During *Nightwater* the whole family has the chance to play the night away.
