Night Water at White Water: Even Cooler after Dark!

***Splash & Ride into the Night at Night Water,
Fridays and Saturdays July 1 to Mid-August***

(Branson, Mo. 6/11) The only thing cooler than a day of water rides, slides and wave surfing is a night of riding, sliding and surfing under the stars! Back by popular demand, it's **Night Water at White Water, kicking off July 1 and running every Friday and Saturday into mid-August. During Night Water, guests can splash all day and into the night with a one-day ticket or season pass, or come after 5 p.m. for five hours of fun for just \$25 per person -- the whole family can play the night away until 10 p.m.**

For the first time ever, **guests can float under the stars in the all-new Aloha River at Hula Hula Bay**, a river adventure 800-plus feet long and filled with 300,000 gallons of water -- the park's longest, wettest, coolest ride yet. Guests can surf the 500,000 gallon wave pool at dusk, raft the challenging Ohana Falls under the stars, and maneuver Raging River Rapids and the Bermuda Triangle in the dark.

For the adventurous, the region's largest high-speed water ride is the ultimate after-dark thrill. Take in the lights of B-town from the top of Kalani Towers before plunging 75 feet on one of the 300-foot drop slides, freefall body sliding at speeds up to 40 mph, or race friends and family on one of the four 312-foot lane slides, racing at speeds up to 25 miles per hour.

Even the youngest members of the family can play under the stars at Night Water, at the new *Coconut Cove*, an expanded, fun-filled kids play area, or *Splashaway Cay*, an interactive family attraction with slides, pumps, geysers and a 700-gallon tipping bucket.
